 Money of Maryland of their Bodies Goods and Chattels and Tenements jointly  
 and severally to be made good to the use of the Inhabitants of Somerset County  
 for the time being if it happen that said Acquittas Mellings his heirs Executors  
 Adors or any or either of them do not from time to time and at all times  
 hereafter acquit discharge save harm as well of the Justices of Somerset  
 County Court for the time being as also of the Inhabitants of said County of and from  
 all costs charges troubles whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintainance  
 and nourishing bringing up of the said Child of or from another Oute  
 troubles and Demands whatsoever touching the mourning of the said Child.
