 hundred & twenty four at y^e Parish of y^e County of Kent within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon certain Joar Guyer in the peace of
 of the Lord Prop. of thousands there being with force & Arms an Assault
 Make & her the Joar thousand there did beat wound & Evilly treat so that
 of her life it was much Dispared & other harms to her than there did by
 great Damage of the same Joar and contrary to the peace of y^e Lord
 Prop. of that now is in good Rule & Government & wherefore the
 Lord Prop. of the Due process of Law against the wife Mary Wilson in this
 part hath to answer to the wife Lord Prop. of upon y^e Promises
 M Howard

And the wife Mary here to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chester in y^e County
 the sixteenth Day of March Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and twenty
 four came into Court and saith that she cannot give any the information
 as was against her brought nor can she say but that she is guilty of
 promises above upon her imposed as by the information it is alleged
 and thereupon submits by Court

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit at the Court house in the Town
 of Chester in y^e County the sixteenth Day of March Anno Domini Seventeen
 hundred and twenty four that y^e wife Mary pay to the Right Honourable
 the Lord Prop. of this Province the Sum of fifty Pounds of Good Lawfull
 fine
