

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State shall, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, and, being passed upon a yeas and nay vote, supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.*

#### SENATE BILL NO. 1 FAVORABLY REPORTED BY COMMITTEE ON ELECTIONS.

Mr. Meyers, from Committee on Elections, reported favorably Senate Bill No. 1, entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 33 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Elections,' sub-title 'Registration,' the said new section to follow immediately after Section 29 and to be known as Section 29A of said Article, changing the dates for the general registration of voters and the revision of the registry books in Baltimore City, in the year 1930, and modifying the provisions with respect to the revision of the registry books for the purpose of making the same conform to the dates so fixed."
