use of his Lord Ship his Servants & Successors Conditionally that if he did not appear on Monday the 22nd instant June to answer unto what is that should be objected against him on Suspicion of felony And also before the same Justice Henry Trubock and William Carter his Justices authorized unto Recoginairice in the sume of four pound Sterl each to be recovered as oft as conditionally that of the said Thomas Travice Should not appear on Monday the 22nd of this instant June before unto what should be objected against him on Suspicion of felony And at the next Court the same orders that the same Thomas be called to appear to the afo Recoginairice Proclamation being made and the afo Thomas Travice being solemnly called to appear according to the law of this Recoginairice to have the forfeiture of the sume afofo Justices for his Appearance the same Thomas Travice being solemnly called afo but makes default worth do any person come and show cause why the same Should not be forfieid: Wherefore it is givn recd by the Justices here to wit at the Court house in the Town of Chelmsford County the
anno Domini Seven hundred and thirty three that the afo Thomas Travice his Recoginairice in the sume of four pound Sterl and the afo Henry Trubock and William Carter in the sume of four pound Sterl each be afforfeid to the use of his Lord Ship his Servants and Successors etc
