

use of his Lordship his Honor & Successors conditionally that if he did not appear on Monday the 22^d Instant June to answer unto what should be objected against him on suspicion of felony and also before the same Justice Henry Trulock and William Cator his Sureties entered into Recognizance in the Sum of five pounds Sterl each to be forsworn as aforesaid conditionally that if the said Thomas Tracie should not appear on Monday the 22^d of this Instant June to answer unto what should be objected against him on suspicion of felony

and at the said Court the same orders that the said Thomas be called to appear to the said Recognizance proclamation being made and the said Thomas Tracie being solemnly called to appear according to the tenor of his Recognizance to save the forfeiture of the same as aforesaid Sureties for his appearance the said Thomas Tracie being solemnly called as aforesaid but makes default with. do any of you come and show cause why the same should not be forfeited: therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit at the Court

house in the Town of West^m in said County on the Anno Domini Seventeen Hundred and thirty that the said Thomas Tracie his Recognizance in the Sum of five pounds Sterl and the said Henry Trulock and William Cator in the Sum of five pounds Sterl each be all forfeited to the use of his said Lord Ship his Honor and Successors &c
