

God to the evil example of all others in such case offending contrary to the  
 Peace of the said Lord Proprietor his good rule and Government and against the form  
 of the Act of Assembly in that case made & provided wherefore the said Attorney  
 brought the advice of the Court here in the premises for the said Lord Proprietor and  
 due process of Law against the said Mary in this part to issue to answer to  
 the said Lord Proprietor of and upon the premises as —

AND The said Mary now here at the said Court to wit the seventeenth  
 day of Nov. Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty cometh and appears in  
 her proper person. — AND Saith that she cannot gainsay the  
 Judgment and so as she against her brought nor but that she is guilty of the  
 premises above her imposed as by the said Judgment it is alleged & thereof  
 she submits to the Court. Therefore it is considered by the Justices  
 here to wit at New County and at the Court House in the Town of Chester in  
 said County on the third twoday in Nov. being the seventeenth day of said  
 Month Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty that the said Mary do  
 receive on her bare back twenty Lashes well laid on her bare back till the  
 blood app. for her offense of fornication and Inform and Confess as also the  
 sum of two hundred and seventy pounds of Tobacco Cost according to the  
 premises and to the officers of this Court &c. — *J. Smith*

It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day  
 and year last mentioned that the Sheriff of New County take the said  
 Mary Parker into his custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment  
 aforesaid and afterwards to bring her into Court again —  
 which precept to wit Joseph Young Gent. Sheriff of New  
 County return on the day & year last said that he hath executed  
 the punishment in the said Judgment and also hath here the said Mary  
 Parker before the Court for executing this

Commanded it was to the Sheriff of New County that he  
 should immediately bring before this Court the said  
 Sam<sup>r</sup> Clark to answer unto a certain Judgment of  
 assault and Joseph Young Gent. Sheriff of the same  
 County according to the exigency of the affair came and made return to the Court  
 here on the third twoday in Nov. being the seventeenth day of said Month  
 Anno Domini Seventeen hundred and thirty Endorsed as follows by *Joseph Young*  
*Sherrif*

 now is for the body of New County and upon their Oath do present that Samuel Clark  
 of S. Pauls Parish in the County and Planter the first day of August Anno Domini
