Philip Carroll of Kent County sh<sup>o</sup> came into Court and acknowledged himselfe indebted to the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of ten pounds Sterl to be levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if the said Philip Carroll shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in March next then and there to answer unto the said Indulm. of Forfeiture, wherewith he acknowledged himselfe content.

Likewise at the same Court came Robert Key of the said County sh<sup>o</sup> and acknowledged himselfe indebted to the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of ten pounds Sterl to be levied on his body goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs and Successors Conditionally that if he the said Philip Carroll shall not make his personal appearance at the next Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in March next then and there to answer unto the said Indulm. of Forfeiture, wherewith he acknowledged himselfe content.

Ordered by the Court here that Security be given for Margaret Falconer as an Indulm. against the said Philip

Whereupon William Frisby of Kent County sh<sup>o</sup> acknowledged himselfe indebted to the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of five pounds Sterl to be made & levied on his body goods & Chattels Lands & Tenements to the use of his said Lord Ship his heirs & Successors Conditionally that if the said Margaret Falconer shall not appear and answer to an Indulm. for his said Lord Ship in the next Court of the said Philip Carroll at next March Court to be held for said County on the third Tuesday in March next, wherewith he acknowledged himselfe content.
