G. To St. Vincent de Paul Society, in the City of Baltimore, Md., Twenty-five hundred dollars.

H. To the Oblate Sisters of Providence in the City of Baltimore, Md., Five hundred dollars.

I. To St. Mary's Industrial School for Boys, Five hundred dollars.

J. To the Board of Managers of Dolan Children's Aid Society, One thousand dollars.

K. To the Catholic University of America, Washington, D. C., Five thousand dollars.

L. To Rev. J. Dougherty, or in case of his death to the then Pastor of St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church, Norfolk, Virginia, for the Parochial School attached to said Church and paid to Rev. James T. O'Farrell the successor of Rev. J. Dougherty, One thousand dollars

M. To Rev. Thomas J.
