To the Institute for the Blind, Sisters of St. Joseph of Peace, a body corporate called in said will, St. Joseph's Home of Jersey City, New Jersey, a corporation created under the laws of the State of New Jersey, the sum of Three hundred dollars for the uses and purposes set forth in said will.
