HOUSE BILLS—FIRST READING.

House Bill No. 2—By Mr. White (Speaker):

A Bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sub-sections (c) (3) and (c) (5) of Section 7 of Article 95A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1943 Supplement), title 'Unemployment Compensation', sub-title 'Contributions' (as said sub-sections were amended by Chapters 270 and 768 of the Acts of 1945), eliminating the provisions excluding certain employers from the benefits of the Merit Rating provisions, and providing for a re-determination of the contribution rate of certain employers on and after October 1, 1945, and providing that this Act shall not operate to discharge any liability or obligation due or existing on September 30, 1945."

Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Finance.
