SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 54 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "Carroll County", sub-title "Elections", as said section was amended by Chapter 361 of the Acts of 1939, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

54. The Supervisors of Elections of Carroll County shall receive an annual salary of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) each. The secretary to the Supervisors of Elections shall receive an annual salary of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). The attorney for the Supervisors of Elections shall receive an annual salary of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). All other expenses shall be in the discretion of the County Commissioners of said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1941.

CHAPTER 809.

(House Bill 790)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 60 and 61 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "County Treasurer", eliminating certain obsolete provisions, making said sections conform and making certain minor changes in certain provisions relating to the County Treasurer of St. Mary's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 60 and 61 of Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1930 Edition), title "St. Mary's County", sub-title "County Treasurer", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

60. (a) At the general election held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November every fourth year, account-
