

CHAPTER 83.

CHAP. 84.

AN ACT to add the following sections, relating to an Act to authorise the County Commissioners of Harford county, to lay out and establish a Public Landing on the Susquehanna river, at Lapidum or Bell's Ferry, in said county, to Article 12 of the Public Local Laws. Passed Feb. 16, 1860.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Harford county, be and they are hereby authorised, if in their judgment the public convenience shall require it, to locate, establish and improve a public landing on the Susquehanna river, at or near Lapidum or Bell's Ferry, in said county. County commissioners empowered to locate landing.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the same proceedings shall be had to locate, improve and establish said public landing as are now required by law to open a public road. Proceedings.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 84.

AN ACT to amend the Act of eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, chapter twenty, entitled, An Act to lay out and establish a new Election District out of Dames District Number Four, in Somerset county, to be called Tangier District, or Election District Number Fifteen. Passed Feb. 24, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the second section of the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, chapter twenty, entitled, an act to lay out and establish a new election district in Somerset county, out of Dames Quarter district number four, to be called Tangier district, or election district number fifteen, be and the same is hereby repealed.
