CHAPTER 87.

Passed Feb. 17, 1860. AN ACT to amend the twenty-first article of the Code of Public Local Law, relating to Election Districts in Washington county, by adding thereto the following section:

Addition to article 21. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following section shall be added to article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Law:

New election districts, &c. That the commissioners shall have power and authority to create new election districts in addition to those already established whenever in their judgment the convenience of the voters of the county or any part thereof would thereby be promoted, and shall also have power to abridge or enlarge any districts heretofore established by the Legislature or which may hereafter be established by said commissioners, and shall have the further power to designate the place of holding the election polls in all election districts.
