

election days caused by the distance they must travel to exercise the right of suffrage; Therefore, CHAP. 89.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section ninety-one of article twenty-first of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the number of election districts of Washington county, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following be enacted as a substitute therefor: Section 91 of Article 21.

SEC. 1. *And be it enacted,* That Washington county is divided into thirteen election district according to the present bounds and limits, but the county commissioners may in their discretion subdivide the said districts and create new ones or may in their discretion abridge or enlarge the same. Election districts.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. In force.

## CHAPTER 89.

AN ACT entitled, an act to amend the one hundred and eighteenth section of the eighteenth article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the pay of the Sheriff of Saint Mary's county, for keeping prisoners by increasing said pay. Passed Feb. 24, 1860.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sheriff of Saint Mary's county, shall be entitled to forty cents a day for keeping in jail and boarding each prisoner. Price of board.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the one hundred and eighteenth section of the eighteenth article of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the boarding of prisoners in Saint Mary's county, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. Repealed.
