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CHAPTER 62.

(Senate Bill 45)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 15 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Administration", to clarify said section by eliminating the unnecessary sentence at the end of the section.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 15 of Article 93 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1939 Edition), title "Testamentary Law", sub-title "Administration", be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

15. Whenever any person shall die intestate, leaving in this State personal estate, letters of administration may forthwith be granted by the orphans' court of the county wherein was the party's mansion house or residence; or in case he had no mansion or residence within the State, letters shall be granted in the county where the party died; and in case the party neither had mansion or residence nor died within this State, letters may be granted in the county wherein lies or is supposed to lie a considerable part of the party's personal estate.
