CHAPTER 1.

CHAP. I.

*A supplement to an act, entitled an act to incorporate the Trustees of Union Town Academy, in Carroll County.* Passed Jan. 1, 1841.

WHEREAS, by the second section of an act, entitled an act to incorporate the trustees of Uniontown academy, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, chapter two hundred and forty-three, it was required that an election should be held on the first day of January, of each and every year thereafter, for trustees; and whereas, the requirements of said sections were not complied with: therefore,
