At an Extra Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, convened by Proclamation of the Governor, at the City of Annapolis, on Wednesday, the twenty-fourth day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, and ended on the seventh day of April, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one:
