1843.

Resolution in favor of William M'Neir.

2, 1844.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer pay to William M'Neir, the sum of ninety dollars, it being the amount paid by him to the clerk of the Court of Appeals for copies of the laws passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-two.

No. 32.

Resolution in favor of Capt. L. O. Harn.

Passed March
2, 1844.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Adjutant General be, and he is hereby directed to furnish to the order of Capt. L. O. Harn, of the Union Rifle Company, of Hagerstown, fifty Knapsacks, out of such as are at this time in the Armory, by his giving satisfactory security for their safe keeping and return; and the like number to Capt. William Small and E. B. Baltzell, of Frederick county, and to Capt. William P. Maulsby, of the Carroll Infantry, upon their giving security for their return.

No. 33.

Resolution in favor of Elizabeth Hammond.

Passed March
5, 1844.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer pay to Elizabeth Hammond, of Frederick county, or order, during her life, the half pay of a private, in consideration of services rendered by her husband during the revolutionary war.
