Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That it shall be the duty procure lot to of the trustees of each of the respective school districts aforesaid, as soon as practicable after the passage of this act, to acquire by purchase, or gift, a site of not less than one acre of land at or near the place fixed upon by the commissioners aforesaid, or at some central point within the limits of said districts, to be secured by deed, or otherwise, to said trustees, and their successors in office, for the use of said schools, and to cause to be erected thereon a comfortable school house Erect there of sufficient dimensions for the convenient accommodation of at least thirty scholars, and to defray the ex-Payment nenses thereof out of the fund, and in the manner hereinafter provided.
