At a session of the General Assembly of Maryland, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on the last Monday of December, being the thirtieth day of said month, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, and ended the sixth of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine,

CHAPTER 1.

CHAP. I.

An act to empower the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick, to sell the Market House in West Patrick street, and apply the proceeds to the erection of Public Pumps in Bentz Town, in Frederick.

Passed Jan. 14,
1839.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick be authorised, empowered and required to sell, at public or private sale, as in their judgment they may deem best, the market house situate in West Patrick street, in Frederick; and they are*
