Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the capital stock of said company shall not be less than four thousand dollars, nor more than fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of twenty dollars each, to be raised by subscription, and that the said company shall have the right to purchase and hold land, not exceeding eight hundred acres, in Talbot county.

CHAPTER 348.

An act to incorporate the Rock Hall Silk Company, in Kent County. Passed April 3, 1839.
