CHAP. 136.

An act to grant to Henry S. Sanderson, late Sheriff of Baltimore County, further time to complete his collections. Passed Jan. 16, 1840.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Time extended
That the time limited by law, within which the late sheriff of Baltimore county shall have made his collections, be and the same is hereby extended to the first day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.

CHAPTER 136.

An act to incorporate the Mount Vernon Beneficial Society of Baltimore. Passed Jan. 18, 1840.

WHEREAS, Matthias Schrate, Israel Price, Nicholas Preamble
Peregoy, John Dohm, John Howell, Eli Tucker, William
Woodcock, Nathaniel T. Hatch, Emanuel T. Forsythe,
William Richardson, and others, have formed themselves
into a society for the laudable purpose of affording relief to
each other and their respective families in the event of
sickness, distress and death, and have prayed for an act
of incorporation that they may better execute their bene-
volent intentions—therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Matthias Schrate, Israel Price, Nicholas Peregoy, John Dohm, John Howell, Eli Tucker, William Woodcock, Nathaniel T. Hatch, Emanuel T. Forsythe, William Richardson, and others, who now are or may hereafter become members of said society, and their successors, are hereby declared to be one community and body corporate forever, by the name, style and title of the Mount Vernon Beneficial Society of Baltimore, and by that name they shall be and are hereby made able and capable in law, to receive contributions, and purchase, possess, enjoy and retain to them and their successors, lands, tenements, rents, annuities or other hereditaments, and the same to dispose of in such manner as they may judge most conducive to the interest of the said society; *provided,* that the said corporation or body politic, shall not at any one time hold or possess property, real, personal or
