MAGISTRATES' COURTS—District justices of the district courts in Frederick county, to be entitled to fees according to the provisions of the act of 1835, ch. 201, instead of per diem allowance, &c.

The 24th section of the act of 1835, ch. 201, repealed, so far as relates to Frederick county, except so much providing that the chief justices shall furnish to the levy courts, &c. of the several counties, before the first of June each year, a full statement of the amount of fees received by said judges,

MARYLAND PENITENTIARY—Purveyor to, to be appointed, in lieu of the two agents appointed by the act of 1837, ch. 320, to visit daily the said Penitentiary, and to perform the duties which may have been heretofore performed by the agents, &c.

Purveyor to give bond in the sum of \$15,000 before he enters upon his duties, for their faithful performance, to be approved by the directors, and not to be connected in any manner with the management of the Penitentiary,

Salary \$700, to be paid out of the funds of the institution,

So much of the act of 1837, ch. 320, as is inconsistent with this act, repealed,
