**CHAPTER 1.**

**CHAP. I.**

*A supplement to an act passed at December session eight-  
teen hundred and forty-six, chapter two hundred and  
fifty-two, entitled, an act relating to the School Fund  
in Harford County.*

Passed  
Dec. 31, 1847.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of* Orphans court  
*Maryland, That the orphans court of Harford county* authorized to  
*be, and it is hereby authorised and empowered to pay* pay teachers.  
*rateably, from the school fund of said county now sub-*  
*ject to the draft of said orphans court, the accounts,*  
*proven under oath, of the teachers of indigent children*
