If no appeal bond is accepted by justice the officer making arrest and seizure to give ten days notice by public advertisement and sell all such property seized and taken under this law, 8 3 5

If resistance be made to the sheriff or other officer engaged in the execution of this law such resistance deemed a misdemeanor, " " 6

After paying costs of prosecution one-half of balance to be paid to officer who made the arrest and seizure and balance to the school fund of, " " 7

Act to provide for making an index of judgments and decrees for the circuit court of, and directing the county commissioners to levy a tax sufficient to pay for the same, 64 64

The clerk directed to enter names upon index of all defendants against whom judgments have been rendered, " " 1

When judgment rendered has been superceded clerk shall enter names of all persons superceding the same, " " 2

The clerk directed to index all judgments standing open on the docket of said court for twelve years last past, with names of all the persons against whom said judgments have been rendered or superceded, " " 3
