

mission shall include, but shall not necessarily be limited to, the American Legion, Catholic War Veterans, World War I Veterans, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Jewish War Veterans, United Spanish War Veterans, Disabled American Veterans, Army and Navy Legion of Valor, American Veterans of World War II, and Military Order of the Purple Heart.

The Governor shall designate a Chairman of the Special Commission. The Commission shall organize promptly following appointment and shall give thorough study to the question of a veterans' bonus and to other veterans' legislation in this State. Included in the study of a veterans' bonus shall be possibilities for the financing of such a measure. The Special Commission shall report the results of its study, together with any recommendations it may wish to make, to the members of the General Assembly of Maryland not later than December 15, 1958.

Any Department, Board, Bureau, Commission, or other agency is authorized to cooperate with and assist the Special Commission during the performance of its work. THREE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, SIX MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND, THREE REPRESENTATIVES OF VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS AND THREE REPRESENTATIVE CITIZENS AND TAXPAYERS, WHO MAY OR MAY NOT BE MEMBERS OF ANY VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL ORGANIZE PROMPTLY FOLLOWING APPOINTMENT AND SHALL SELECT ITS OWN CHAIRMAN AND SHALL GIVE THOROUGH STUDY TO THE QUESTION OF A VETERANS BONUS AND TO OTHER VETERANS' LEGISLATION IN THIS STATE. INCLUDED IN THE STUDY OF A VETERANS BONUS SHALL BE THE POSSIBILITIES FOR THE FINANCING OF SUCH A MEASURE. THE SPECIAL COMMISSION SHALL REPORT THE RESULTS OF ITS STUDY, TOGETHER WITH ANY RECOMMENDATIONS IT MAY WISH TO MAKE, TO THE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND NOT LATER THAN DECEMBER 15, 1958.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect on June 1, 1958.
