*Provided, however, that beginning with the school year 1958-1959, for the purpose of the calculation of payments to be made to the board of education of any county or the Mayor and City Council of the City of Baltimore under the Equalization Fund formula as used by the State Department of Education, as well as for the purposes of the actual minimum salaries required to be paid hereunder, the State minimum salary schedule for the basis of such calculation for every teacher, with a degree, shall be according to the following schedule:*

And further provided that, after the year **[1955-1956]** ~~1958-1959~~ 1957-1958, both for the purposes of actual minimum salary payments and for the purposes of equalization, nothing contained herein shall require the actual payment or calculation of annual payment to any teacher in excess of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) above the required payment for the previous year, using the above limiting scale of **[1955-1956]** ~~1958-1959~~ 1957-1958 as a base.

(d) For the school year **[1955-1956]** ~~1957-1958~~ and thereafter, any such teacher having charge of a two-teacher school, shall receive \$200 per school year more than the appropriate foregoing schedule requires. A principal of a school, holding a regular principal's certificate, shall receive the following amount in excess of the appropriate schedule required for teachers as provided in Sub-section (b) or Sub-section (c) of this section for schools with the following number of assistant teachers:

*And provided further that for the purposes of this sub-section a principal of a school with thirty or more assistants shall be employed*
