Act to make valid and amend articles of incorporation of the Boys' School of St. Paul's Parish, in the city of Baltimore, incorporated under the act of 1846, chapter 323, entitled an act to authorise incorporations in certain cases,

Act to amend the act entitled an act to incorporate the Frederick and Emmettsburg Turnpike Company, passed at December session, 1844, chapter 136, and to authorise said company to charge toll upon the whole length of their road now finished, and to repeal the sixth section of said act,

To recognise the Preston Iron and Coal Company of the State of Virginia, as a corporation, and authorising it to exercise the powers and privileges of a corporation within the State of Maryland, for mining and manufacturing purposes,

Act to amend an act entitled an act to incorporate the Fremont Savings Institution of Baltimore, by allowing said institution the privileges embraced under the act entitled an act to continue the corporate existence of the several banking institutions therein mentioned, passed at January session, 1853, chapter 441,
