Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17, of the Maryland Constitution, I am returning to you House Bill No. 568 which has been vetoed by me.

This particular Bill is a Cecil County local Bill designed to increase the number of County Commissioners in that County from three to five and to create County Commissioner districts from which each Commissioner would have to be elected.

I have recently been advised by the sponsor of this Bill, Delegate William F. Burkley, that, in his opinion, the Bill, as passed, does not meet with the purpose for which it was introduced, and that he desires the Bill to be vetoed.

As a result of the request of the sponsor, I am vetoing this Bill and am forwarding it to you, along with my veto message.
