A Bill entitled "An Act to add new Article 78C to the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), to follow immediately after Article 78B thereof and to be entitled 'Maryland Harness Racing Commission', to establish a Maryland Harness Racing Commission to have jurisdiction over trotting and pacing racing in the State, to authorize licensing of harness racing tracks, and to provide for the regulation of harness racing in this State."
