### VETOED BILLS

*Dear Mr. President:*

I am advised that as a result of a Constitutional Amendment adopted by the voters of our State in 1960, it is unnecessary for me to return to your Honorable Body my veto messages on Bills passed during the 1962 Session and subsequently vetoed by me.

However, as a courtesy to you and the other members of the Senate, I am making available to you copies of all of my veto messages in order that your Body will be fully familiar with my reasons for taking the action that I have taken on vetoed Bills.

I have today vetoed Senate Bill No. 35. This Bill pertained to Inheritance Tax on small estates, consisting solely of two or less motor vehicles.
