

operate branches and to grant unto the said railroad company the right, power and privilege to enter upon, take and appropriate lands and materials for any of said purposes, as well as for all its railroad purposes, and to possess the same powers and privileges, and be subject to the same restrictions and limitations granted to and imposed upon railroad companies incorporated under the General Corporation Laws of this State." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.*]

Also House Bill No. 265, entitled "An Act to repeal Section 457 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, as enacted by Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1898, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Fish.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Fish and Game.*]

Also House Bill No. 206, entitled "An Act to prohibit the taking or catching of clams in the waters of Somerset county, except by residents of said county, who have obtained a license to do so, and providing penalties." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries.*]

Also House Bill No. 256, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 285-A of Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Harford county,' sub-title 'Wild Fowl,' and to name said Section 285." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Fish and Game.*]

Also House Bill No. 360, entitled "An Act to close a portion of Herring Bay, Anne Arundel county, now set apart for tonging oysters, from the twenty-fifth of April, to the first day of December, in each year." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries.*]

Also House Bill No. 352, entitled "An Act to repeal Section 148 of Chapter 88 of the Acts of 1902, and of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany county,' sub-title 'Frostburg,' providing for the collection of taxes and water rents in the town of Frostburg and to re-enact the same with amendments." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Zihlman, Speicher and Kaufman.*]
