By the President: Senate Bill No. 596, entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest contained in the will of Mary Loretta Hunter, late of Baltimore city, deceased, to St. Ignatius' Roman Catholic Church." *[Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings.]*

By the President: Senate Bill No. 597, entitled "An Act to amend and enlarge the powers conferred by the Act entitled 'An Act to confirm the charter of St. Anthony's Orphan Asylum in Baltimore city, incorporated on the tenth day of April, 1858, under the General Laws of Maryland, and to enlarge the powers of said corporation,' passed at the March Session, 1860, Chapter 151." *[Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.]*
