

Also House Bill No. 647, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 1, 2 and 3 of Chapter 230 of the Acts of 1902, entitled 'An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county, to levy a sum of money not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500) to build a school house for white children at or near Laurel Grove, in the Sixth Election District of St. Mary's county.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Chesley, Mudd and Joy.*]

Also House Bill No. 633, entitled "An Act to repeal Chapter 364 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Session of 1912, entitled 'An Act to regulate the salaries of school teachers in Wicomico county, Maryland, and to provide for the levying by the County Commissioners of said county of the funds necessary to provide for the payment of the salaries of such teachers.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Bennett, Harrison and Shepherd.*]

Also House Bill No. 631, entitled "An Act to prohibit non-residents from hauling a seine or fishing with gill-nets, fikes, traps or set nets of any kind in the creeks, coves, branches and tributaries of Middle River, in Baltimore county, other than in the river proper, without first obtaining the permission in writing of the owners or occupiers of the banks or shores of such creeks, coves, branches and tributaries aforesaid, in front of which any such seine or nets may be placed, and to provide a penalty therefor." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries.*]

Also House Bill No. 623, entitled "An Act to repeal Section 29-A of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Elections,' sub-title 'Registrations' and to re-enact, with amendments." [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Elections.*]

Also House Bill No. 617, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments Section 8 of Chapter 430 of the Acts of 1888, entitled 'An Act to incorporate The Community of Mountain Lake Park.'" [*Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."*] [*Which was read the first time and referred to Senators Speicher, Zihlman and Bomberger.*]
