

1961, Ch. 206—Statewide Referendum

I, LLOYD L. SIMPKINS, SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, pursuant to the direction contained in Section 172 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1957 Edition,) DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that at the General Election held in the State of Maryland on November 6, 1962, an Act known as Chapter 206 of the Acts of 1961, was submitted to the voters of the State of Maryland pursuant to the provisions of Article XVI of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, said Act being as follows:

“An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 159, 162 and 164 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition), title ‘Elections,’ subtitle ‘House of Representatives,’ and to add a new Section 166A to said Article and subtitle, to follow immediately after Section 166 thereof, creating a new eighth congressional district in the State of Maryland, making changes in certain other districts in conformity therewith, making provision for the application of this Act and relating generally to the several congressional districts of the State of Maryland and the tenure of the several Representatives from the State of Maryland.”

AND I DO CERTIFY that at said election 115,557 votes were cast in favor of the adoption of Chapter 206 of the Acts of 1961, and 211,904 votes were cast against adoption of said Chapter 206 of the Acts of 1961, the said Act has therefore failed of ratification.
