Subject: "ELECTIONS," subtitle "HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES," RELATING GENERALLY TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SEVERAL CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS IN THIS STATE.

Amendments to House Bill No. 38

By the Baltimore City Delegation, offered from the floor:

Amendment No. 1—On page 2 of the printed bill, Section 162, strike out lines 2 and 3 and insert the following:

"The Third Congressional District is composed of Wards 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 26 and Precincts 1 through 77 of Ward 27 in Baltimore City."

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 2—On page 2 of the printed bill, Section 163, strike out all of lines 2 and 3 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"The Fourth Congressional District is composed of Wards 4, 5, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17; Precincts 78 to 105 of the 27th Ward; and all of the 28th Ward in Baltimore City."

Which amendment was read and adopted.

Amendment No. 3—On page 2 of the printed bill, Section 164, strike out all of lines 2, 3 and 4 and insert the following:

"The Fifth Congressional District is composed of Anne Arundel County and Wards 2, 3, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25 in Baltimore City."

Amendment No. 1—On page 2 of the printed bill, Section 162, line 2, strike out "third" and insert "fourth".
