

CHAPTER 341

(House Bill 519)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 238, of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Cumulative Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "State Department of Assessments and Taxation," relating to the salaries of assessors and assessors' aides, in Baltimore County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 238, of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Cumulative Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "State Department of Assessments and Taxation," be and it hereby is repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

238. Salaries in Baltimore County—Assessors and assessors' aides.

(a) Baltimore County, Maryland, shall be authorized and directed to levy and pay each assessor of Baltimore County a salary as specified in Standard Salary Grade ~~【XXVI】~~ XXVIII as established by the Personnel and Salary Advisory Board of Baltimore County, Maryland, from time to time, including increments for time served and longevity specified for such grade, provided, however, that service of assessors as such prior to June 30, ~~【1965】~~ 1966, shall be taken into consideration in determining the salary payable to each such assessor and provided further that the portion of said salary to be paid by the State shall be limited to the amount provided in the schedule set forth in Section 237 of this article.

(b) Baltimore County, Maryland, shall be authorized and directed to levy and pay to each assessor's aide of Baltimore County a salary as specified in standard salary grade ~~【XXI】~~ XXIII as established by the Personnel and Salary Advisory Board of Baltimore County, Maryland, from time to time, including increments for time served and longevity specified for such grade, provided, however, that service of assessors' aides as such prior to June 30, ~~【1965】~~ 1966, shall be taken into consideration in determining the salary payable to each such assessor's aide and provided further that the portion of said salary to be paid by the State shall be limited to the amount provided in the schedule set forth in Section 237 of this article.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That it is not intended that reference to Standard Salary Grades established by the Personnel and Salary Advisory Board of Baltimore County, Maryland, should subject assessors or assessors' aides to the jurisdiction of the Personnel and Salary Advisory Board of Baltimore County, Maryland, but is merely for the purpose of establishing the compensation payable to such employees.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1966.
