No person shall be committed to or confined as a patient in any institution, public, corporate or private, or almshouse or other place for the care and custody of the [insane] *mentally ill*, ~~idiotic~~ MENTALLY RETARDED or the alcoholic except upon the written certificates of two qualified physicians of the State of Maryland made within one week after separate examination by them of said alleged [lunatic] *mentally ill* PERSON or alcoholic and setting forth the [insanity] *mental illness*, ~~idiosis~~ MENTAL RETARDATION or alcoholism of such person and the reason for such opinion. No certificate shall be of force which shall be presented for the commitment of any patient more than thirty days after date of examination. The form of physician's certificate shall be substantially as follows:

This section shall not apply to the cases of voluntary commitments as provided for in Section 37.
