CHAPTER 448

(House Bill 455)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 40(p) (2), of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1965 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact," subtitle "State's Attorney," relating to the increase in the number of Assistant State's Attorneys to five. IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 40(p) (2) of Article 10 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1965 Supplement), title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact," subtitle "State's Attorney," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

40.

(p) (2) The State's Attorney may appoint a deputy State's Attorney and **[four]** *five* assistant State's attorneys. The deputy State's attorney's salary shall be not less than thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) nor more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) to be determined by the County Council in its discretion. The assistant State's attorneys' salaries shall be not less than eight thousand dollars (\$8,000) each nor more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each to be determined by the County Council in its discretion. The deputy State's attorney and the **[four]** *five* assistant State's attorneys shall devote their full time and attention to the duties of their offices and shall not engage in the private practice of law at any time in any jurisdiction during their tenure of office.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1967.

CHAPTER 449

(House Bill 546)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 108 (15) (h) of Article 52 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1965 Supplement), title "Justices of the Peace," subtitle "Trial Magistrates System," to provide in Montgomery
