shall have custody of all such monies. Each branch clerk shall report promptly to the chief clerk all fines, forfeitures and costs and shall report any funds in his custody. The chief clerk shall prepare, sign and deliver with appropriate remittances to county and State officials such reports of fines, forfeitures and costs as are required of trial magistrates by law. The chief clerk, the deputy chief clerk and the several branch clerks shall perform such other duties as shall be properly assigned to them by the Judges of the People's Court, and they shall receive such salary as shall be fixed by the County Council of said County in equal monthly installments; the chief clerk before entering upon his duties shall give bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) and the said branch clerks and [chief deputy clerk] deputy chief clerk before entering upon their duties shall each give bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00); said bonds shall have corporate sureties satisfactory to said County Council, the premium of said bonds to be paid by the County Council of Montgomery County. The County Council for Montgomery County shall provide such additional clerical help as may be necessary to carry out the administrative work of said Court and its branches at salaries to be fixed by said County Council for Montgomery County.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1966.

CHAPTER 450

(House Bill 547)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 32B of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1965 Supplement), title "Courts," subtitle "Circuit Courts for the Counties—Court Stenographers," providing for two additional Circuit Court Judges for Montgomery County, to be selected as provided by Section 5 of Article 4 of the Maryland Constitution.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 32B of Article 26 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1965 Supplement), title "Courts," subtitle "Circuit Courts for the Counties—Court Stenographers," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

32B.

In addition to the six judges for the sixth judicial circuit for which provision is made by Section 21 of Article 4 of the Constitution of Maryland and in addition to the one judge for which provision was made in Chapter 894, 1965 Laws of Maryland, there shall be cone two additional judges who shall be a residents of Montgomery County. Said judges shall be selected in the manner provided by Section 5 of Article 4 of the Constitution of Maryland and shall be
