

Circuit Court for Prince George's County upon the request of the resident judges of Prince George's County the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) annually in addition to the salary received by each of said Judges from the State of Maryland, said payments to be made from and after June 1, 1965, in equal monthly installments, and in addition the said County Commissioners are further authorized and directed to pay to each of said Judges who reside in Prince George's County an annual expense account not to exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00); and the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to levy upon the assessable property of the said county a tax sufficient to pay the aforesaid amounts.]

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That Section 5-8 of the Code of Frederick County, Maryland 1959, being Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," subtitle "Courts," subheading "Article II, Circuit Court," as this section was last amended by Chapter 363 of the Acts of 1965, be and it is hereby repealed as follows:

§5-8.

The county commissioners are authorized to pay to each of the judges of the circuit court for the sixth judicial circuit who reside in the county a sum not to exceed four thousand five hundred dollars annually, in addition to the salary received by each judge from the State. Such payments shall be made in equal monthly installments. The county commissioners are hereby authorized to levy upon the assessable property of the county a tax sufficient to pay such amounts.]

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That Section 7-16 of the Montgomery County Code 1960, being Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Montgomery County, title "Montgomery County," subtitle "Courts," subheading "Article II, Circuit Court Generally," be and it is hereby repealed as follows:

§7-16.

The county council is authorized to pay to each of the judges of the circuit court for the sixth judicial circuit who reside in the county a sum not to exceed four thousand five hundred dollars annually, in addition to the salary received by each of such judges from the State. Such payments are to be made from and after the date of passage of this section in equal monthly installments, and the county is hereby authorized to levy upon the assessable property of the county a tax sufficient to pay the aforesaid amounts.]

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted,* That all laws or parts of laws, public general or public local, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

SEC. 6. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1967.
