and Where," to follow immediately after Section 9 (11G) thereof, providing a certain tax exemption for farming implements AND LIVESTOCK in Wicomico County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Section 9 (11H) be and it is hereby added to Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1965 Replacement Volume and 1967 Supplement), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "What Shall be Taxed and Where," to follow immediately after Section 9 (11G) thereof, and to read as follows:

9 (11H).

For the purposes of county taxation in Wicomico County, the farming implements AND LIVESTOCK of any bona fide farmer as now taxed shall be exempt in increasing amounts over a three year period beginning July 1, 1968. The exemption in increasing amounts shall be in equal ratios for each of the three years until at the end of the three year period and thereafter these implements AND LIVESTOCK shall be entirely exempt from assessment and taxation.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1968.

CHAPTER 596

(Senate Bill 579)

AN ACT to add new Section 714C to Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Replacement Volume and 1967 Supplement), title "Natural Resources," subtitle "Oysters and Clams,"; AND TO REPEAL AND RE-ENACT, WITH AMENDMENTS, SECTION 715 (A) OF SAID ARTICLE, TITLE AND SUBTITLE OF SAID CODE, to authorize and regulate the taking of soft-shell clams by hydraulic dredges in Dorchester County, AND PROVISIONS FOR LOCAL REFERENDUM IN SAID COUNTY.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That new Section 714C be and it is hereby added to Article 66C of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1967 Replacement Volume and 1967 Supplement), title "Natural Resources," subtitle "Oysters and Clams," AND THAT SECTION 715 (A) OF SAID ARTICLE, TITLE AND SUBTITLE OF SAID CODE IS HEREBY REPEALED AND RE-ENACTED, WITH AMENDMENTS, to authorize and regulate the taking of soft-shell clams by hydraulic dredges in Dorchester County, AND PROVISION FOR LOCAL REFERENDUM, AND ALL TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(a) How to apply for hydraulic dredge license—Any person wishing to take or catch soft shell clams (Mya arenaria) with any hydraulic or mechanical dredge or rig in the waters of Dorchester
