CHAPTER 419
(House Bill 51)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection (e) of Section 1(70) of Chapter 780 of the Laws of Maryland, 1959, being also Subsection (e) of Section 59-75, Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County (1963 Edition), Title "Prince George's County," subtitle "Park and Planning Commission," and Subsection (e) of Section 70-81, Montgomery County Code (1965 Edition), Title "Montgomery County," subtitle "Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission," to clarify the authority of the Montgomery County Council ~~and the Prince George's County Commissioners~~ to require street dedication as a condition for approval of a subdivision plat by the Commission.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Subsection (e) of Section 1(70) of Chapter 780 of the Laws of Maryland, 1959, as amended, be, and is hereby, repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

70.

(e) Street dedication. The Commission shall have the power to require dedications of streets and roads in connection with the
