

Duty in their respective Offices or Employments from the further Execution of his or their respective Office or Offices, And we do hereby authorize and empower ^{also} the said Alexander Spotswood to allot Order settle from time to time the salaries or Allowances which each Deputy, Officer Agent or Servant who shall be employed in or about the said posts shall be paid for their Trouble, Care or Charge in their respective Offices And we do hereby Give Grant and Appoint to the said Alexander Spotswood for his Care, pains & Trouble in the performance and Execution of his Office and trust hereby Granted Committed unto him, and he is to receive or be allowed in his Accounts Out of the Revenue arising to his Majesty by the post of Letters within the said provinces and Dominions, such yearly Salary and also such further Allowances Emoluments and Advantages and in such Manner as is and are contained and Menoed to be so given Granted and allowed him in and by certain Articles of Agreement bearing even date with this Our Deputation or Deed of Poll, and made or mencoed to be made between us & the said Edward Carteret and Edward Harrison Esqrs his Majest. Postmaster General of the One part and the said Honorable Alexander Spotswood of the Other part. And we do hereby Suppose Revoke and make null and void all and Every other Deputation Constitution, or appointment, made Given or Granted by us or by any former Postmaster General to John Lloyd Esq. or to any other person or persons whatsoever to execute the Office of Deputy Postmaster General or to Manage the posts Settled in his Majesties provinces and Dominions in America or any part thereof And do hereby Declare the Same to be from the twenty fourth day of June Next ensuing null and void, and do hereby further Depute authorize to appoint the said Alexander Spotswood to Enter on and take possession of his said Office Trust, any other Deputation Constitution or appointment whatsoever notwithstanding. In witness whereof the said Edward Carteret & Edward Harrison Esqrs have hereunto set our Hand and caused the Seal of our Office to be hereunto affixed this ninth day of February 1729.
