shall be tried, shall recite generally and briefly the title and number of such rule or regulation, with the date of its passage, a description of the offense in words of common usage, or if the rule or regulation has been embraced in a codification, if it refers to the number of the section of such codification and conforms to the rules of law governing the framing of indictments for violation of Acts of the General Assembly of this State and concludes "against the form of the rule or regulation in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State."

SEC. 2. Effective date.

This Act shall take effect on December 7, 1970.
