

LEVY DATE ON WHICH THE TAXPAYER BECOMES ORIGINALLY ELIGIBLE AND APPLIES FOR THE TAX CREDITS SPECIFIED ABOVE.

IF AN ELIGIBLE TAXPAYER BECOMES INELIGIBLE IN ANY FISCAL YEAR FOR THE TAX CREDITS SPECIFIED ABOVE, AND THEREAFTER BECOMES ELIGIBLE AND APPLIES FOR THOSE TAX CREDITS IN ANOTHER FISCAL YEAR, THE TAX CREDIT PROVIDED BY THIS SUBSECTION (A-2) SHALL BE GRANTED TO THE TAXPAYER IN SUCH AN AMOUNT THAT THE TAXPAYER'S REAL PROPERTY TAXES REMAIN UNCHANGED FROM THE AMOUNT OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAXES LEVIED FOR THE FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THE TAXPAYER ORIGINALLY BECAME ELIGIBLE FOR THE TAX CREDITS SPECIFIED ABOVE, BUT NO EARLIER THAN JULY 1, 1973.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.

CHAPTER 868

(House Bill 1431)

AN ACT to add new Section 22C to the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset County (1963 Edition, being Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Somerset County," subtitle "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after Section 22B thereof, as added by Chapter 14 of the Acts of 1972, to authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Somerset County to borrow money for the construction of a [[medical]] dispensary in the Brinkley's Election District.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 22C be and it is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws of Somerset County (1963 Edition, being Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Somerset County," subtitle "County Commissioners," to follow immediately after Section 22B thereof, as added by Chapter 14 of the Acts of 1972, and to read as follows:

22C.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SOMERSET COUNTY MAY BORROW APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A [[MEDICAL]] DISPENSARY IN THE BRINKLEY'S ELECTION DISTRICT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1973.
