the Charter shall be by ballot; and upon each ballot there shall be printed the words "For the Charter Amendment" and "Against the Charter Amendment". If a majority of the votes cast in said election shall be in favor of the proposed amendment, such amendment shall stand adopted from and after the thirtieth (30th) day following said election; but if a majority of the votes cast in the election shall be against the proposed amendment, then the provisions of this Ordinance shall be null and void and of no effect.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Charter of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, by repealing and re-enacting, with amendments, Section 507 thereof, Article V, "The Executive Branch", and by adding new Section 550A to said Charter, under the title "The Operating Departments", and under the new heading of "Human Relations Commission", to establish the Human Relations Commission, to provide for its administration, functions, organization and operation; and matters generally related thereto; and to submit said amendment to the qualified voters of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, for their adoption or rejection.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, MARYLAND, That Section 507, Article V, "The Executive Branch", of the Charter of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Section 507. Departments.

There shall be the following departments under the immediate direction and control of the County Executive: Department of Public Works, Department of Inspections and Permits, Department of Police, Department of Fire, Department of Recreation and
