<u>HEALTH OFFICER</u> REQUIRES RAT-PROOFING

[[DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS]] COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO REQUIRE THAT ANY PROPOSED OR EXISTING FOOD BUSINESS STRUCTURE BE RAT-PROOFED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUB-TITLE.

[[3]] 12.705 RULES AND REGULATIONS

THE [[DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS]] COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS AND PURPOSES OF THIS SUB-TITLE, ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE:

- (A) THE [[DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS]]

 COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER SHALL PREPARE A PROPOSED

 SET OF RULES AND REGULATIONS TO REQUIRE THAT

 PROPOSED OR EXISTING STRUCTURES BE RAT-PROOFED.
- THE [[DIRECTOR]] HEALTH OFFICER SHALL SUBMIT THE PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS TO THE RAT CONTROL COMMISSION, WHICH SHALL SET A TIME AND DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND ADVERTISE IT IN TWO SEPARATE INSERTIONS AT WEEKLY INTERVALS ONE OR MORE OF THE NEWSPAPERS PUBLISHED IN THE COUNTY. WITHIN FIFTEEN (15) DAYS SUBSEQUENT THE DATE OF THE HEARING, THE RAT CONTROL COMMISSION SHALL FORWARD THE PROPOSED RULES REGULATIONS WITH ANY RECOMMENDATIONS OR FINDINGS TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, WHO SHALL FORWARD PROPOSED RULES AND REGULATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS AND FINDINGS OF THE RAT CONTROL COMMISSION TO THE COUNTY COUNCIL FOR ADOPTION BY RESOLUTION.
