each duly constituted chamber of commerce within the fire area.

(c) Such representative shall be selected in such manner as may be determined by the governing bodies of the respective citizens' associations, cities, towns, villages, special taxing areas and chambers of commerce. However, no person shall be eligible to serve as a member of the Fire Area Committee unless he be both an actual resident and real estate taxpayer within the Kensington Fire Area. Such representatives so chosen shall be designated annually in writing to the Kensington Fire Area Committee by a duly authorized officer of the respective citizens' associations, cities, towns, villages, special taxing areas or chambers of commerce. Such designation shall have no effect unless accompanied by a certification that the body making the same meets the requirements of this section and that the member so designated is in fact a resident and real estate taxpayer of the fire area.

(d) The Kensington Fire Area Committee shall meet not later than the first day of December of the year 1953, and at least annually thereafter, at such time as may be determined by the members thereof, for the purpose of electing members of the Kensington Fire Board, and at such other time, upon the call of the chairman thereof, as may be necessary to fill any vacancies occurring in the Fire Board.

(e) The members of the Fire Area Committee shall serve without compensation. At its first meeting, and annually thereafter, the Fire Area Committee shall elect a chairman and such other officers as it may deem advisable. The chairman shall serve as such until his successor shall have been duly chosen and qualified.

SECTION 13. Section 43-4, title "Fire board created; how constituted," Chapter 43, title "Upper Montgomery County," of the Montgomery County Code 1965, as amended, is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Sec. 43-1. Fire Board created; how constituted.

There is hereby created a Fire Board to manage the finances of the Upper Montgomery County Volunteer
