OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT AMEND OR REPEAL ANY LAW RELATING TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AND STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, RELATING TO WATER AND WATER STRUCTURES, OR ANY ACT OR PARTS OF ACTS CONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE. THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT IMPAIR ANY RIPARIAN OR OTHER VESTED RIGHT, NOR AMEND, REPEAL, LIMIT, IMPAIR, OR ALTER ANY RIGHT, POWER, OR PRIVILEGE GRANTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BAITIMCRE, TO APPROPRIATE OR USE ANY RIVER, STREAM, OR WATER IN THE STATE TO AUGMENT AND IMPROVE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY OF BALTIMORE CITY. ALSO, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT PROHIBIT, LIMIT, IMPAIR, CR ALTER ANY PARTICULAR USE OF ANY STREAM OR BODY OF WATER IN EXISTENCE ON JANUARY 1, 1934 BY ANY PERSON UNLESS THE USE SUBSEQUENTLY IS ABANDONED.

8-813. ENFORCEMENT OF SUBTITLE BY INJUNCTION.

ON APPLICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT, VERIFIED BY OATH OR AFFIRMATION, THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANY COUNTY, SITTING IN EQUITY, MAY ENFORCE BY INJUNCTION, COMPLIANCE WITH, OR RESTRAINT FROM VIOLATING OR ATTEMPTING TO VIOLATE ANY PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY DEPARTMENT ORDER, NOTICE, RULE, OR REGULATION MADE UNDER IT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Article 96A, section 20 of the Code. The final sentence is proposed for deletion since the substance of it is covered in section 1-101 of this Article. 8-814. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF SUBTITLE.

ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES OR CAUSES AN ACT WHICH VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE OR VIOLATES OR FAILS TO COMPLY WITH ANY ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT
